5	SPAT1	<p><b>Adult MLTE Single Pitch Award (SPA) Training</b></p> <p><b>This is a 2-day course</b> This is a nationally accredited qualification training course.</p> <p>The SPA qualification allows the holder to set up and supervise single pitch rock climbing activities on outdoor crags as well as rock climbing activities on indoor climbing walls.</p> <p>Candidates are to ensure they have registered with the MLTE for the SPA scheme prior to the course and have acquired the essential pre-course logbook experience 15 rock climbs. 7	MFA1	<p><b>Adult Mountain First Aid (MFA)</b></p> <p><b>This is a 2-day course</b> This course is delivered by Peak First Aid. It is a first aid course that is specifically designed for Leaders/Instructors working in the outdoor wilderness environment.
