



Non-Disclosed SCC ADULTS – Attendance on National/Area/District/Unit Courses and Events

Recently there have been a number of incidents of SCC adult volunteers applying for, and attending, Unit, District, Area and national training courses and events before they are formally enrolled into the SCC or have been through the MSSC Disclosure process. In some instances this has resulted in the volunteer being asked to leave the course/event. If an SCC adult volunteer is not disclosed through the MSSC then they are not formally enrolled into the organisation which means they are not eligible to attend SCC training courses and events but more importantly may not be insured by the MOD or MSSC.

Course Directors/Event Directors are not to accept SCC adults onto their courses and/or events unless the adult has a disclosure through the MSSC. (In order to assist Course Directors, in version 1.4 of Westminster, any applications from non-disclosed adults will appear in red on the Adult Students page until such time as their disclosure date is officially recorded). Adults may attend Units on a few occasions to familiarise themselves with the activities of a sea cadet unit, but must not have unsupervised access to cadets. Thereafter they should only attend once they have been fully enrolled, which includes having the disclosure process completed.
