The MSSC have been offered an excellent deal by the sole supplier of Rigiflex boats who are prepared to sell the NEWMATIC hulls to Sea Cadet units at commercial rates rather than retail prices making an excellent saving to those wishing to purchase this sturdy work boat.

Included in the much reduced price will be 2 warps, anchor, warp and chain, 2 fenders and 5 RYA G16 Safety Boat Handbooks which is equivalent to about £100 of kit.

Popular with the emergency services, environment agency and numerous marinas this craft is perfect for safety boat duties and general purpose boating.

The boat that is most likely to be of interest to units will be the NEW MATIC 360. Its sturdy construction and easy maintenance puts it at the top of its class. Well-equipped, stable, quick and practical it would be ideally suited to unit use.



This package is on offer for the next 12 months and is designed to be advantageous to the organisation.

In addition, Rigiflex are loaning the MSSC an example of the boat which will be circulated around Area Boat Stations between March and October. It is hoped this will be powered by a Suzuki engine for which a **separate** beneficial package has been arranged with Suzuki GB for units wishing to purchase the outboard as well. If the units who do not wish to purchase a Suzuki engine Rigiflex will be able to offer normal commercial rates on other engines types.
