## CADET 150 TRI-SERVICE DUKE OF EDINBURGH'S AWARD GOLD RESIDENTIAL COURSE 11-19<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2010

1. Cadet150 is a Tri-Service project designed to celebrate and promote the success and values of the cadet movement in its 150<sup>th</sup> year in 2010. As part of the celebrations it has been decided to hold a Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DofE) gold Residential Course at Britannia Royal Naval College (BRNC) Dartmouth. The DofE residential course will run from Friday 12<sup>th</sup> to Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> August 2010. It is hoped that a Royal Naval ship will be able to collect a number of cadets on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> August 2010, from Portsmouth and deliver them to Dartmouth. Applicants should therefore be available from 11<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> August 2010.
2. The Sea Cadets have been allocated 30 places, applicants must meet the following criteria at the time of residential course.
  - Cadet (Not a young adult)
  - Registered with the DofE as undertaking the Gold DofE Award and in possession of a Gold Award book (award books allow the change of operating authority OA to MSSC)
  - Prior to the course has 'not' completed the 'RESIDENTIAL' section of the DofE award.
  - Suitable for a Royal visit/formal dinner with speakers & media/press contact.
3. Minimum age of applicants will be sixteen and maximum age seventeen on 11<sup>th</sup> August 2010.
4. Those who attend will achieve:
  - Completion of the Residential section of Gold DofE book
  - Foundation Certificate in DofE Leadership
  - Certificate of introduction into the DofE award
5. The cost to each cadet will be between £40 and £50 towards the following items
  - Course attendance
  - Workbook & DofE sectional Certificates
  - CD Photographic record of the weeks activities
  - Polo shirt & T-shirt
  - An evening meal with inspirational speaker
  - Disco
6. The cost will be payable in full on confirmation of place and applications are to be forwarded to ASO (DofE) by 5<sup>th</sup> April 2010.
