FRIMLEY PARK CADET LEADERSHIP COURSE 2010

1. The 2010 Cadet Tri-Service Leadership courses will be conducted at the Cadet Training Centre (CTC) Frimley Park as follows:

Frimley Park Course 1 - Join Sunday 4 July depart Saturday 10 July 2010

Frimley Park Course 2 - Join Sunday 11 July depart Saturday 17 July 2010

Frimley Park Course 3 - Join Sunday 18 July depart Saturday 24 July 2010

2. The courses are open to male and female Sea Cadets and PPOs/PSgts who must be **over 16 and less than 18 years 9 months** of age during the course, minimum rank/rate Cadet Corporal/Leading Cadet.

3. The SCC has an allocation of 12 cadet places and 1 staff place per week. There are no restrictions on gender. As there are restricted places available please get your applications in early to secure a place.

4. The course is predominantly practical and is consequently physically demanding; those considering participation should be fit and able to undertake physical activities. Fitness requirements are spelled out on the ACF Certificate of Consent and Fitness form, as per attachment on Westminster. The syllabus is not oriented towards the training of any particular service but does include; early morning fitness, lecturettes, elementary camp craft, map and compass work, skill at arms (cadet GP rifles), patrolling, orienteering, march and shoot competitions, inter-section/service sports, assault boat race, two night patrol exercises, a lengthy exercise involving competitive activities, plus many others, all are taxing but mostly fun. All who successfully pass the course are provided with a leadership report and are permitted to wear a Frimley Park Leadership Badge.

5. This course is a joint ACF/ATC/CCF/SCC Course and will allow participants an excellent opportunity to meet cadets from the other Organisations. All Sea Cadets and Marine Cadets will gain a great deal from this course and we ask all Commanding Officers to encourage as much participation as possible from all Cadets.

6. Course fees are £35 per Cadet and are to be paid in full to MSSCHQ. Applicants place will not be confirmed until payment is received.

7. **Applications are to be completed on Westminster. Applicants are then required to complete an Application Consent Form and the ACF Application and Certificate of consent and fitness forms and forward this along with full payment to Nicola Martin at MSSCHQ, 202 Lambeth Road, London SE1 7JW.**

8. Please note that all applications must be completed on Westminster and forwarded to MSSCHQ no later than **Monday 26th April 2010**. Applicants who have attended before will not be accepted.

9. There is a requirement for adult instructors/supervisors. Applicants must be fit, with an adventurous training interest and be prepared to supervise cadets and organise practical leadership tasks. Volunteers should forward complete an application on Westminster and forward an Application Consent Form to Nicola Martin at MSSCHQ by Monday 26th April 2010.
