District Camp Friday 25 to Tuesday 29 May 2012

Activities will include: Boat work at Jupiter Point and Leadership and Teamwork in the harbour at Pier Cellars.

INTRODUCTION

This year, the bank holiday has been moved to coincide with HM the Queen's Diamond Jubilee and therefore, the camp falls the week before the school half term holiday.

1. This camp is less formal than the camps aboard HMS Bristol and is ideal for younger cadets to experience a naval routine without the additional pressure of progressing to a qualification. Older cadets benefit by further developing their leadership skills.
2. Cadets will only be permitted to attend if there are staff from the Unit attending plus Units will be required to supply one buoyancy aid for each cadet attending.
3. A day's trip to the seaside at Looe is planned and Cadets will be allowed to visit the various attractions in small groups. CO/OiCs are recommended to obtain supervision requirements from parents.
4. The outline programme is:
 - Day 1: Arrival at Pier Cellars, settle into accommodation. Walk to Cawsands beach.
 - Day 2: Red Watch Boating, Green Watch Leadership and Teamwork
 - Day 3: Green Watch Boating, Red Watch Leadership and Teamwork
 - Day 4: Trip to Looe
 - Day 5: Return home
5. The cost of this camp is Cadets: £55, Adults £35. Units are to collect payments and bring **cash** for the full amount to the camp.

 - Up to two weeks before the camp - full refund.
 - Less than two weeks before the camp - £20 will be deducted.
 - No show at camp – no refund
