### REMINDERS:

New Adults are reminded that they **MUST** attend the AIC Course within 6 months of being appointed. Once they have completed 6 months probation and the AIC they then need to apply to become APO/ASGTs. They must then complete the AFA and IM within 12 months. Currently the AIC courses are under subscribed and adults will run the risk of being asked to leave the SCC if they do not complete the modules in the time scale as per SCRs. Unit Commanding Officers/Officers-in-Charge need to ensure these modules are completed.

**Juniors:** Under **NO** circumstances should Junior Sea Cadets undertake any specialisation training or gain any 3<sup>rd</sup> Class qualifications as per ASCR T25 (guide to Junior Sea Cadet Programme). If you're in any doubt please speak to ASO Juniors (via your CO).
