



COMMUNICATIONS SPECIALISATION COURSES

1. As you will no doubt be aware the Communications Specialisation is undergoing a revision and a rewrite of the syllabus. During the period until the new syllabus and training requirements are published all adult training and Class 2 and 1 training for both (G) and (T) sub-specialisations have been put on hold. However, communications Class 3 courses can continue to be run until nearer to the changeover date when further instructions will be given.
2. However, exceptional permission has been granted to run two final courses; these will consist of a Communications Class 1(G) course and a Communications Class 1(T) course specifically for Cadets who need the Class 1 qualification for advancement. Both courses will be run together at Kettering Sea Cadet Unit over two week-ends ends **03-05 June & 10-12 June 2011**. Attendance at both week-ends is required and cadets must have passed Comms Class 2 for the relevant sub-specialisation.
3. The courses have been entered onto Westminster and are open for applications.
4. Further details on the new syllabus, conversion courses for adult instructors and any other information will be published once known. Information is being published on the HQ Training and Admin website as it becomes available.
