1. The courses listed below are undersubscribed so please give them your urgent attention as the Director of Music has received no replies to date:

26 - 28 September Adult Instructor Course

2. Accommodation for the cadet courses will be on HMS BRISTOL (I hope). Accommodation for the adult course will be in HMS NELSON. All courses join on the Sunday. Joining instructions and course programme will be issued soonest.

3. There are spaces for 10 cadets on each Cadet Course and there must be two uniformed adults as supervisors who will also be part of the course. There are 10 places for adults on the adult course. **NB. NO CADETS CATERED FOR ON THIS COURSE**


4. Like previous courses places should be filled by more proficient players and certainly anyone with a view to making a career in the RMBS as a Bugler. A reasonable level of proficiency is required on at least one instrument. **This course is not suitable for novices.**

5. Although these Courses will appear on Westminster, self booking is not allowed and all applications must be reviewed by ASO Music then sent on to the Director of Music before final selections. There is nothing to stop cadets (or adults) attending more than once, but clearly if there is competition for places, those that have not been before will take precedence over those who have.
