

6. Qualifications: Rowing, Paddlesport and Boat Handling. Commanding Officers are to ensure that all those entered for events are of the correct age, have the correct qualifications and those certificates have been handed to Adult staff who will be attending the event. **Contravention of these instructions will mean that the cadet(s) will NOT take part.**

7. Dress: The dress for the event is as follows:

Cadets in camp - 4's for Sat Breakfast/Evening Meal, (If no time to change from competition otherwise civvies).

Cadets Venue - Sports rig for event, 4s for prize giving.

Cadets in camp - civvies for Sun Breakfast.

Adults in camp - 3's (a,b,c) for Breakfast/Evening Meal (If no time to change from competition).

Adults Venue - 3's (a,b,c)

Judges/Officials - as appropriate for task.

Area Officials/Team Managers - 3's (a,b,c) for prize giving.

Adults in camp - civvies for Sun Breakfast.

8. Venue Extra: As you are aware we have been experiencing quite warm weather. Therefore ALL District Team Managers are to ensure their cadets/adults have sufficient amount of water available and are to be seen drinking this on a regular basis.

District teams should consider bringing:-

- Water bottles - Free juice/ drinks are available from within the Clubhouse but all other products will be for sale at a reasonable cost
- Tents / Gazebo Shelters / camping chairs / groundsheet to sit on – Districts / Units / Spectators are encouraged to bring with them some form of shelter, i.e. Gazebos. We have secured an area nearer the waters edge for the purpose of viewing the races. Duty Staff and Officials will guide you on boundaries.
- Sun creams / sun screen / sun / rain umbrellas – suitable products should be briefed to individuals for bringing to the event.

Heads and Showers are available inside the Clubhouse but once personnel have completed their task are to leave. Cleanliness within the Clubhouse and surrounding areas outside are to be kept clean and tidy. Duty personnel will be patrolling to ensure this.


It is the duty of everyone to keep the area clean and tidy. No one is to leave the venue, whether staying at camp or leaving for home units, until instructed to do so by ARO/Reg Officer. T1s will need to be collected from FA before leaving for home.

9. Venue Access: Two entrances are available from the main road (North/South). The southern entrance has been graded and should not present a problem, however the northern entrance has had the holes filled in but is still quite uneven (Towing Boats!). **ARO(E) will liaise with coach drivers Friday evening to enlighten them about the approach. Units using coaches are to bring this to the attention of the driver and contact ARO(E) on arrival at the camp.**

Transport to / from Lincoln for Powerboat handling will be organised on the Friday evening so that teams are fully aware of travel arrangements.

Parking of vehicles will be strictly controlled at the venue. This will be in the control of Captain Fuller RMR and his staff. **All** are to comply with instructions given.

10. Briefings: Adults will have a briefing at the camp Friday Night. Team managers will then brief their cadets after this. Team managers are to ensure NO cadet miss this.
ASO (Boats) and his staff + ASO (Paddlesport) and his staff will ensure watersafety briefs are given to all participants at the venue on Saturday morning specific to their event.
11. Boats: All boats (Trinity 500 / safety boats / yole) requested for use at the event should be delivered direct to Girton on the Friday evening and unloaded to the beach area. No boats should be taken to Beckingham camp.
12. Trophies: Districts/Units who won trophies at the 2010 competition are to clean and sign back the trophies to **ARO (E)** on arrival at the camp **Friday Night**. Further Instructions may be given at the competition. If you are not sure ASK.
