AREA PADDLESPORE COURSE 16 – 18 September 2011

There has been an amendment to the previous advertised Course. The BCU/UKCC Level 1 Coach Course has now been replaced by the SCC Level 1 Coach Course in August and September.

*Anyone who was hoping to do the BCU/UKCC Level 1 Course, please be advised that there is a National Course running: **Please contact ASO (Paddlesport) for details.***

1. The Course will offer training and assessment to Cadets and/or Staff in the following qualifications:
 - a. BCU Start / 1* / Paddlepower Passport
(Open to Cadets and Adults)(pre-requisite - Ability to be able to swim to the current SCC required standard.)
 - b. BCU 2* - Part 1 Training / Paddlepower Discover
(Open to Cadets and Adults)(pre-requisite – Ability to be able to swim to the current SCC required standard. The ability to paddle to a BCU 1 Generic Standard.)*
 - c. SCC Level 1 Coach –Part 2
(Open to Adults and Cadets 16+) (pre-requisites New BCU 2 + FSRT + Valid First Aid Certificate (min 8hrs)+ Fully Enrolled in SCC + CRB Checked for SCC Adult Staff + Attended SCC Level 1 Coach – Part 1 Course)*
2. The Course will be held over the weekend of 16 - 18 September 2011, at the Eastern Area Canoe Centre, TS TUNA, Bedford SCC, Longholme Way, Bedford, MK41 9LW.
3. The cost of courses above is £25.00 per person. Minimum £5.00 deposit must be sent with the appropriate application form off Westminster.


