EASTERN AREA SCC EXPEDITION CHALLENGE 2011

1. The 2011 Eastern Area Expedition Challenge will take place from Friday 16 to Sunday 18 September 2011 at Robin Hood Campsite which is located at Ricketts Lane, Blidworth, Mansfield, Nottinghamshire, NG21 0NF.
2. One senior and one junior team per District will be allowed.
3. The closing date for entry is Monday 12 September 2011. There is an entry fee of £12 per team. Cheques are to be made payable to MSSC. Entries should be made using Westminster (approved entries by District Officer).
4. If Districts have not selected their teams by the closing date they may submit an entry via their District Officer to the ASO (ET+ML), prior to the commencement of the Challenge.
5. Each team of 4 cadets must be accompanied by a Team Manager, who will act as Marshall during the challenge. If there are female cadets in the teams there must be a female team instructor per District who is prepared to sleep out in the field.
6. Teams are to consist of:

JUNIOR TEAM

4 Cadets any rate aged 12 years on the first day of Challenge - 14 years on the last day of Challenge.

SENIOR TEAM

4 Cadets any rate aged 15 years on the first day of Challenge - 17 years on the last day of Challenge.


Teams may consist of cadets of either gender or a mixed team. However male and female cadets must have separate tents.
