Assessments should be carried out either on a continuous basis or at the end of the course by the instructor or Unit Training Officer.

Five levels of assessment should be considered:

- (5) VERY GOOD - Very knowledge
- (4) GOOD - Above average knowledge
- (3) SATISFACTORY - Average knowledge
- * (2) BELOW AVERAGE - Adequate but with gaps in knowledge
- * (1) POOR - Weak knowledge

* Cadets assessed as BELOW AVERAGE and POOR must be re-assessed before being advanced to the next rate.
