CADET 150 TRI-SERVICE DUKE OF EDINBURGH'S AWARD GOLD RESIDENTIAL COURSE 11 - 19 AUGUST 2010

1. Cadet150 is a Tri-Service project designed to celebrate and promote the success and values of the cadet movement in its 150th year in 2010. As part of the celebrations it has been decided to hold a Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DofE) Gold Residential Course at Britannia Royal Naval College (BRNC), Dartmouth. The DofE residential course will run from Friday 12th to Thursday 19th August 2010. It is hoped that a Royal Naval ship will be able to collect a number of cadets on Wednesday 11th August 2010, from Portsmouth and deliver them to Dartmouth. Applicants should therefore be available from 11th to 19th August 2010.
2. The Sea Cadets have been allocated twenty places, applicants must meet the following criteria:
 - Cadet - NOT a young adult.
 - Registered with the DofE as undertaking the Gold DofE Award and in possession of a Gold Award book (award books allow the change of operating authority OA to MSSC).
 - Prior to the course has 'not' completed the 'RESIDENTIAL' section of the DofE Award.
 - Suitable for a Royal visit / formal dinner with speakers & Media / Press contact.
3. Minimum age of applicants will be sixteen and maximum age seventeen on 11 August 2010.
4. Those who attend will achieve:
 - Completion of the Residential section of Gold DofE book.
 - Foundation Certificate in Leadership
 - Certificate of introduction into the DofE Award.
5. The cost to each Cadet will be between £40 and £50 towards the following items:
 - Course attendance with Royal visitor
 - Workbook & DofE sectional Certificates
 - CD Photographic record of the week's activities
 - Polo shirt & T-shirt
 - An evening meal with inspirational speakers
 - Disco

The cost will be payable in full, with applications: The exact amount will be confirmed, and bookings on Westminster will be opened in or after November 2009.
